Vistra reviews all its memberships with trade groups, associations, and other third-party organizations annually to discern whether their positions are materially inconsistent with Vistra's views. If Vistra determines that a group is taking a materially inconsistent position from the Company's views, the Company will advocate within the organization to seek to align our positions, and if that is unsuccessful, may withdraw from or otherwise disassociate from that organization. Vistra publishes a voluntary report of its memberships and dues of \$50,000 or greater in this annual Sustainability Report. Vistra's Board of Directors provides oversight as part of its annual review of Vistra's Sustainability Report.
